Dear Parents and Carers,

It is hard to believe we are already over half way through the first term of 2019-20. All students have settled well into their routines and we are beginning to look forward to our Christmas activities.

School life

During the Autumn Term we have been looking at This is your life in English. This has involved looking at what we eat and what we wear compared to different periods in History.

We have been looking at Pop Art inspired by Andy Warhol in Art using the students as the subjects. The final masterpieces will be displayed in the Art room but hopefully you have enjoyed the individual pieces that have come home.

We have started guiding reading groups for some students, where they are either reading a text together and then following it up with written work, or listening to a story, looking at the pictures and following up with a discussion. In maths we have been concentrating on number skills, and using and applying these.

In AQA we have started looking at weather and climate around the world. For creative curriculum we are using clay to make either a Nativity, Christmas or winter scene. Another AQA group session is concentrating on physical/team/co-operation games and activities.

A couple of our older students are walking dogs at Stokenchurch Dog Rescue each week, going to the gym and looking at using public transport for citizenship. Others are building on joint citizenship trips accessing parks and then shops together.
